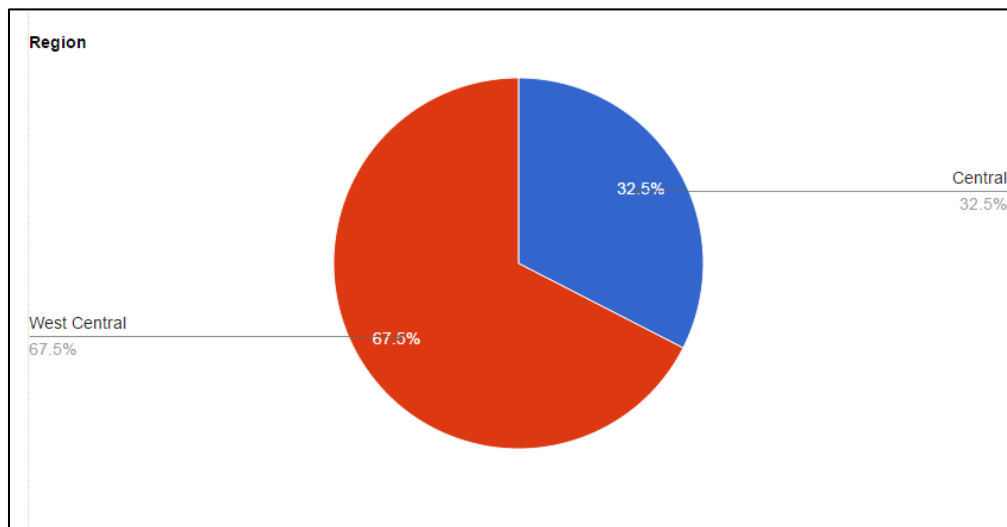

- Coordinated Pine Level Public Art and Archaeology Day in Desoto County in conjunction with Desoto County Historical Society. Dedication and public unveiling of site of Old Pine Level listing on National Register of Historic Places also took place during the event and was culmination of FPAN's collaboration with archaeologist Jana Futch MA during her thesis research while she was a student at USF . Pine Level was Desoto County's first county seat (ca. 1866-1887).
- Conducted a Certified Local Government informational workshop for Citrus County Historic Resources Advisory Board.
- Began Public Volunteer Lab at Weedon Island Cultural and Natural History Center in Pinellas County with materials recovered during USF St. Pete excavations at Weedon Is midden site, under direction of Dr. John Arthur.
