Highlight of the Quarter: HADS comes to St. Augustine

The Northeast Region hosted the first Heritage Awareness Diving Seminar (HADS) in St. Augustine in October, in partnership with the St. Augustine Lighthouse & Maritime Museum and the Lighthouse Archaeological Maritime Program, as well as the Northwest and West Central regions. Staff trained 7 diving professionals on the importance of underwater archaeological resources and how to interact with them.
